



DISCLOSURE OF ELECTRIC LINE CHARGES

Top Energy is required by law to disclose details of line charges.

1. Standard Tariff charges comprise a Fixed Network charge and a variable charge based on units distributed.
2. Each ICP is liable for 1 Fixed Daily charge
3. The standard 15c per day fixed charge provides for 20kVA maximum demand
4. Budgeted transmission charges comprise approximately 29% of the line charges.
5. Unmetered supply tariffs are wholly fixed.
6. Industrial Tariffs for large consumers are customer specific and wholly fixed charges.

All prices are GST exclusive.

NB: These are only the Line charges. In most cases they are charged to an energy trader. Top Energy has no influence as to how the energy trader passes on those charges to their customers.
