Trustees Nominations Called for Power Trust

The Top Energy Consumer Trust has called for nominations for the positions of Trustee. This happens every second year.

Three of the existing Trustees will be required to stand down. Two of them are standing down by rotation and the third, appointed to fill a casual vacancy during the last term, is also required to stand down.

Brian Thorburn, Chairman of the Trust said, "The Trust, through the activities of Top Energy Limited, makes a very significant contribution to the Far North economy and our community. I certainly encourage anyone with an interest in the activities of Top Energy and energy use in Northland to put themselves forward."
